SUMMER ACTIVITIES OF SCHOOL HEALTH AND NUTRITION PERSONNEL

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents
Chiefs of Division, CID and SGOD
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

- In compliance with DepEd Memorandum No. 118, s. 2001, all School Health and Nutrition Personnel are hereby directed to undertake various activities during the summer months of July and August in order to maximize the utilization of Medical and Dental Hub in District Schools by conducting the following activities and healthcare services:
 - a. Health examination of teaching and non-teaching personnel;
 - Render services such as consultations of all teaching and non-teaching personnel with findings on Annual Physical Check-up and giving appropriate intervention and prescription;
 - Monitor for compliance and treatment of teachers and non-teaching personnel found positive for tuberculosis;
 - d. Sign clearance of all teaching and non-teaching DepEd personnel;
 - e. Follow up teachers with ECG significant findings; and
 - f. Perform minor operations such as excision, cauterization, circumcision as referred to Medical Clinic in Schools Division Office.
- Likewise, as per D.O. No. 14 s. 2020, Medical Officers, Nurses, Teaching and Nonteaching, learners and all other concerned personnel must observe the minimum required health standards such as wearing of face masks, regular hand washing, practice social distancing and routine disinfection of surfaces or areas used while rendering DepEd services.
- The list of areas to be visited by the assigned Health and Nutrition Personnel is found in the enclosure.
