CONDUCT OF THE REGIONAL CAPACITY-BUILDING ON ENHANCING CAPABILITIES OF RFTAT AND DFTAT IN TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROVISION FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF SCHOOL STANDARDS TOWARD HIGHER PERFORMANCE

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of RA 9155 or the Governance of Education Act 0f 2001 that emphasizes that every unit in the education bureaucracy is responsible and accountable for continuous improvement of learning outcomes, the Department of Education through the Field Technical Assistance Division (FTAD) shall conduct the Regional Capacity-Building On "Enhancing Capabilities Of RFTAT and DFTAT In Technical Assistance Provision For The Development Of School Standards Toward Higher Performance" to the sixteen Schools Division Offices (SDO) divided into four (4) clusters on November 22-25, 2022.
- 2. This activity has the following aims:

 - 2.2.6 Curriculum and Instruction; and,
 - 2.2.7 Learning Environment.
 - 2.2 Strengthen collaboration between RO and SDO in developing contextualized tools and mechanisms in the provision of TA to schools and prepare them in the challenges of school governance and SBM Validation;
 - 2.3 Enhance the existing tools so that schools can continue in their self-assessment to identify areas for improvement in the aforementioned dimensions in SBM.
 - 2.4 Enhance skills in providing technical assistance and its mechanisms as provided in RM 063, Series 2021.
 - 2.5 Simulate the processes in providing impactful technical assistance with sharing of effective practices and mechanisms.
